Meeting called to order by Jeannie Stall at 7:00 pm

No old business to discuss.

New business:

Jeannie Stall reminded members that dues are now due. Annual CIVTA dues are \$25 and increase to \$35 if not paid by the end of March. Students currently enrolled in a vet tech program only pay 50% dues. It was also discussed that door prizes are for dues paid members only. Members agreed that having a booth at the meeting provides valuable marketing opportunities for the CIVTA Annual Fall Conference. It was decided that until we know the speakers and topics for the meeting that we cannot commit to manning the booth. Several members expressed interest in volunteering if they ended up attending the meeting anyway. DeeDee stated that even if we don't end up having a booth the IVMA will still allow us to hand out brochures or at least make them available at the meeting to attendees. Welcome and dinner

Old business:

Fall Conference Updates discussed. The meeting will start at 2 pm in the Auditorium at the ARL. Jen has taken care of payment for the room rental at the ARL. DeeDee is checking into catering options but she asked for food ideas. It was decided that pasta will not be on the menu for dinner options. Jen will check the approved ARL list of caterers before DeeDee books anything. DeeDee will have the caterer set up during the break prior to dinner so as not to disturb the meeting.

Heart failure and scary cardiac arrhythmias

Basic hallmarks of right and left sided heart failure will be discussed. Common arrhythmias will be looked at ranging from innocent to deadly with discussion of how to examine an ECG strip in a systematic fashion.

Euthanasia and compassion fatigue

Euthanasia is an all too common occurrence that can build to a crescendo level of stress in veterinary team members. Sometimes it's the caregivers that need small tokens of compassion.

When blood pressure bottoms out

Before you place that call to the doctor, "How do you know what the real blood pressure is"? Measuring methods will be discussed as well as what to do if you suspect your patients' pressure has bottomed out.

Geriatric anesthesia and analgesia

Geriatric patients can present certain risks and challenges, and the literature sometimes doesn't tell us a lot of specifics. Discussion of typical changes within the geriatric body and anecdotal opinions of anesthesia considerations will be shared.

Monitoring the critical patient

Discussion includes what to watch for within the major body systems so you may recognize trouble early. Sometimes referred to as a list of 10 or 20, this discussion will hit the high points of watching over a critical patient and when to warn the doctor.
